<b>Select people to receive mailshots</b>				
Previously when sending a mail shot, it was sent only to the main person for each contact record; additional people were ignored. You can now tick a box on the people tab to include additional people in a mail shot as appropriate. Where ticked, each individual will receive their own personalised copy of the letter or email. To control this feature, when clicking the Correspondence button, there is now a new option to select to include "all people" by simply ticking a check box.

<b>Added value of stock on a specific historical date report</b>				
Added a new report to show the value of stock on a specified date (this is similar to the 'Show current stock' report), but allows you to specify a historical date. Requires that you have entered the purchase date for each stock item and that sold items are correctly invoiced through Antiquity when sold.

<b>Added summary totals to stock 'list view'</b>				
At the bottom of the stock list view, you can now see the total values for the found set of records for the following data:				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Total of retail price</li><li>- Total of purchase cost (basic price)</li><li>- Total of purchase cost (total price)</li><li>- Total of sale price</li></ul>				
This means the stock list view can now act as a basic value of stock for the found set of stock items.

<b>New options for printing stock</b>				
When you click the Print button in the stock module, you now have the option to print one full page document per stock record (as previously) or to print a stock list of the found records (new feature).

<b>Website enquiries download complete</b>				
New enquiries made on the website are now downloaded to the database and can be seen in the Reminders page and in the emails page. If the query was from an existing contact (recognised by their email address) it will automatically be added to their correspondence log.

<b>Download new website customers</b>				
You can now download new customers who have registered on the website. You're given the option to link each website customer to an existing contact or to create a new contact.

<b>Download website orders</b>				
For those using the e-commerce features, you can now download orders placed on the website. These orders will be automatically converted to invoices in Antiquity, linked to the customer with the appropriate invoice & delivery addresses selected and the receipt entered. You just have to click one button!

<b>Link to map for addresses</b>				
Added two new buttons in the addresses tab of the contacts screen. Once button pops up a window showing a map of the customer's address and the other shows directions from your business premises to the customer. You can select to use either Google Maps or Multimap in the Admin area.

<b>Creating a new contact</b>				
When creating a new contact, you enter the last name and/or first initial and/or company name in the New/Find screen to check if the person/company already exists in the database. Now, if they do not exist and you proceed to create a new contact, the details you had typed in the New/Find screen are automatically entered into the Last Name, First Name and Company Name fields respectively in the New Person screen.

<b>Upload Trade / Retail Status</b>				
In contacts you can set a customer to Trade or Retail pricing. When they buy, if a stock item has a trade price and the customer is set to trade, they will automatically get the trade price (if there is no trade price for an item, the retail price will always be used). This setting can now be uploaded to the website if the customer has created an account on the website and the same pricing policy will apply when they purchase online. The default setting for customers is always 'Retail'.

<b>Changes to Find feature in Contacts</b>				
In the Admin section, you can now select whether to start a search in the first name, last name or company name field.

<b>Change when entering a new contact</b>				
When entering a new contact name, the "+ Address" button was below the address box. We have now moved the button above the box to indicate that it should be used if you need to enter a new address. Otherwise select an existing address from list. If there are no existing addresses from which to select, the "+ Address" button is now highlighted with a yellow background, again to indicate that this should be clicked.

<b>Added link to contacts website</b>				
Clicking on the label 'web' next to the website address for a contact will now open up their website in your browser window. If there is no web address in the web field, it will attempt to create a web address from the email address. For example, if the email address is andy@abcantiques.co.uk and there is no web address, when you first click the web button, it will put in the web address www.abcantiques.co.uk. If you click the web button again it will open up the website in the browser. Note that some examples such as andy123@hotmail.com or andy123@btconnect.com will logically be pretty useless with these new functions.

<b>HTML Stock email retail / stock price</b>				
When sending the HTML stock email and including any stock items which are set to display the price on the web (which also displays it on emails), the retail or trade price will now be displayed subject to whether each contact is a retail or trade customer (set in the sales tab of the contacts screen). Where no trade price has been entered for a stock item and the price is to be displayed, the retail price will always display in its place.

<b>Date email sent</b>				
Emails are listed in descending order by the date / time they were received. If you hover your mouse over the date received column, it will now also display the date / time they were sent.

<b>Change on opening Antiquity</b>				
When opening Antiquity, the previous found set of records in each module was shown. You now have an added option in the Admin section to show all records in each module on opening.

<b>Include or Exclude VAT option</b>				
When adding non-stock items to an invoice, you can now select whether the price entered was quoted including or excluding VAT. When setting up commonly used non-stock product codes and descriptions in the Admin section, you can similarly select the default VAT setting for each item, e.g. a tin of wax polish is always sold excluding VAT but an hourly charge for design consultancy is always sold including VAT.

<b>Shipping to be charged separately</b>				
If the shipping class on a stock item is 999 - which means 'shipping to be charged separately' - thus allowing the item to be sold online and shipping calculated later, the words 'Shipping to be charged separately' will now be automatically added to the end of the description in red text. Note: There is currently no procedure to ensure that you do actually remember to charge the shipping, so you should create a reminder for yourself (click the 'New Reminder' button at the bottom of the invoice screen).

<b>Added delete option</b> Added a button to delete a purchase order. Note: Purchase order numbers cannot be reused once deleted.

<b>Green dot on stock 'Sales' tab</b> A green dot will now show on the 'Sales Information' tab in the stock module if there is any sales data in there.

<b>Changes to Find feature in Stock</b> In the Admin section, you can now select whether a search in the stock module to, by default, be only items that are 'in-stock' or to search the entire stock book, including sold stock. If set to only search 'in stock', you can still override this when clicking the Find button by also pressing the SHIFT key which will cause it to search all stock records.

<b>Added cost price to stock list view</b> Added the total cost price of an item to the stock list view. The total cost price appears in grey immediately underneath the retail price.

<b>Warning on retail price if too low</b> The retail price field (and trade price field where used) will turn red if the price is below the total cost price of the item. This is just a visual warning that you would be selling at a loss, but it does not stop you selling the item at this price.

<b>Text formatting added in stock description</b> The description text in a stock record can now be formatted with varying fonts, colours, bold, italic, font size etc. Any changes will be converted to HTML and uploaded to the stock page on the website. To edit the formatting, simply highlight (select) a word or paragraph, right click and then use the various formatting options in the menu.

<b>View Cart website link</b> Added a 'View Cart' link on the website which shows regardless of which page you're on. This makes it easier for a user to view their shopping cart at any time. The link does not show if you have turned off the shopping cart feature.

<b>Price hidden automatically after sale</b>				
For stock items that remain on the website after sale, the price will automatically be hidden on the next web update after the item has been invoiced in Antiquity. This happens regardless of whether the 'show price on web' box is checked or not.

<b>Easier to upload new stock to website</b>				
We've made it easier to upload new stock to the website, i.e. you don't have to enter quite as many details as before. You no longer have to enter the shipping class, purchase costs or the sale price. The new (reduced) minimum requirements to upload new stock to the website are: An image, a category, a description, margin scheme selection and the VAT rate (which is entered automatically when you select a stock category). However, items without a price or shipping class cannot be purchased online. Items without purchase costs can be sold online, but the order cannot be processed in Antiquity until the purchase costs have been entered - because it would be impossible to calculate margin scheme VAT (where applicable).

<b>Non UK Addresses &amp; postcodes</b>				
Non UK addresses no longer require a value to be entered in the postcode field. This was causing a problem for non UK addresses because they often don't have postcodes or the postcode needs to appear in a different position.

<b>Changes when an address is deleted</b>				
Improved the functionality when an address is deleted. The 'main' address can no longer be deleted - but you can go to the main person for the contact and select an alternative address for him/her, then delete the address entry. Also when the statement address is deleted, another 'invoice' address is now set as the new statement address where one exists, otherwise the first address listed.

<b>Address postcode lookup</b>				
Antiquity now returns an appropriate error message if you do not have the optional Postcode PA address look up module installed and click the button to look up an address by it's postcode.

<b>Moved Retail / Trade option</b>				
Moved the 'Retail / Trade' option from the Sales tab to the upper right section of the main contacts window to make it easier to find and modify. Also added a security feature so only Admin & Power Users can change the setting to 'trade'.

<b>Website order emails</b>				
When an order is placed on the website, an email is sent to you and will be received in the emails module. Email confirmations of web orders will now appear in red, similar to website enquiries.

<b>Link received email to contact</b>				
When an email is received in Antiquity, if two or more people had a matching email address, a list of matches was displayed from which you could choose. We have now improved the contact details that display in this list to make it easier for you to match the email to a contact.

<b>Changing the invoice date</b>				
You can now change the invoice date to +/- 90 days of the current date. Previously you were limited to +/- 30 days. This change can only be made if the invoice is unlocked (an invoice gets locked when it's printed or a receipt is entered).

<b>New invoice - date field selected first</b>				
When you create a new invoice, the current date is automatically entered and the cursor then started in the 'Sales Person' field. Some people forgot to change the date when entering historical invoices so now the cursor starts in the date field to draw your attention to it.

<b>Creating a new invoice</b>				
Some users were accidentally clicking the "Invoice/Credit Note" button and creating invoices for the wrong customers. We have changed the default options on the pop up dialog when you press this button. The default button is now 'Cancel' instead of 'Invoice'. Also the dialog now shows the customer's name, e.g. "Create an invoice or credit note for Peter Jacobs, ABC Limited?". We also added a restriction whereby you can no longer create an invoice or credit note for a contact where both no person's name and no company name have been entered.

<b>Length of stock description on an invoice</b>				
Previously the full text description of a stock item was displayed on an invoice. This caused problems for long descriptions, often causing invoices to run needlessly into multiple pages. The text of the stock description is now chopped at 70 words.

<b><i>Imperial dimensions now show fractions</i></b>				
Imperial dimensions showed lengths of less than an inch as a decimal part, e.g. 8.25". This is still the same in the Antiquity database when entering data because there is no easy way to enter fractions. However on all printed documents and the website, fractions are now shown as ¼ (.25), ½ (.5) & ¾ (0.75). Any other imperial decimal lengths will still show as entered, e.g. 8.33 will not convert to 8½.

<b><i>Bulk import images</i></b>				
When clicking the camera icon (top centre of the stock screen) to bulk import images, if there was an error report at the end, the top of the report was off the screen. This has been rectified.

<b><i>Deleting images</i></b>				
There is a general rule that you cannot delete anything in the stock book after an item has been sold; this included images. This caused problems in certain situations, so you can now delete images after sale (except for the main image if the item is still being shown on the website).

<b><i>Website PDF improvements</i></b>				
Improved quality of header and footer in website produced PDF documents. We many need to redesign (Photoshop) and reupload beta testers logos to reflect changes.

<b><i>Email spamming protection</i></b>				
We have removed your company email address from the website 'Contact Us' page and changed it to a 'Click here to send us a message' button. This stops web 'robots' scanning your site for your email address and potentially adding you to spam lists. Web robots can no longer see your email address.

<b><i>Slideshow fixes</i></b>				
In the slideshow on the website, the pop up text at the bottom and the pull down selection area at the top both preceded the stock number with the word "Product", e.g. "Product #1234. This word has been changed to "Stock".

<b><i>Bug in mailshot</i></b>				
Fixed a rare bug in HTML stock mailshots where you may have selected 'Send to All' but it only sent to one person.

<b>Website shipping address fix</b>				
If the shipping address for a website order contained an apostrophe, the order failed to be correctly processed.

<b>Shipping insurance when 'do not ship' selected</b>				
The website no longer adds shipping insurance to the total cost if the user has selected the 'do not ship' option.

<b>Upload price to website</b>				
When uploading stock details to the website, if no retail price had been entered, Antiquity previously gave an error message and stopped uploading the stock record. Now, if no retail price has been entered, it will upload, but the option to show the price on the web will be automatically unchecked. Similarly, the option 'Available to buy on web' will also be unchecked.

<b>Website slideshow / order fix</b>				
After loading the website in a browser, if a user clicks on any item in the slideshow, he cannot later drag any stock items into the favourites area or shopping cart. He would have to refresh the home page in his browser to enable him to buy things. Since this solution was not intuitive, he might have given up altogether.

<b>Cancelling creation of a new contact</b>				
Users with the privilege group of 'User' or 'Shop Floor' previously got an error message if they started to create a new contact record and then cancelled.

<b>Menus: Create new contact</b>				
Fixed a bug where the keyboard command CTRL+N was not creating a new record in the contacts module. The same problem occurred when selecting New Contact from the top level pull down menu.

<b>Adding new contact</b>				
When adding a new contact record, you need a minimum of a name and / or a phone number. Just a company name alone is not enough. Previously, if you failed to enter a name or phone number, the entry would have been deleted when you clicked the save button (because it presumed you'd entered nothing useful). Now a warning message is shown asking you to enter some more contact information. A company name alone is still not enough information - this has not changed.

<b>Bug when adding a new person</b>				
Previously, under certain circumstances, the company name (where entered) could have been deleted when adding a new person to an existing contact record.

Fixed a bug where the correspondence preview window was not correctly zooming to the user's zoom preference. To see a preview, hold down the SHIFT key when printing a document (e.g. letter, invoice, receipt etc.)

<b>Error in progress dialog</b>				
When doing a large mail shot (as opposed to an email shot), a dialog appeared showing "omitting records marked as do not contact by email". The dialog should have said "mail" not "email".

<b>"User" level staff could not mail merge</b>				
There was a bug which prevented users with the 'user' level privilege (as opposed to 'Admin', 'Power User' or 'Shop Floor') from performing a mail or email shot.

<b>Bug in correspondence</b>				
If you had previously started to create correspondence to one or more people but cancelled (or just closed the window) and later went to create correspondence to the same or other people, the original recipients might have still been included (or doubled up) in the new correspondence.

<b>Mail merge improvement</b>				
At stage 3 of a mail merge, for contacts where no person's name had been entered on the contact record (e.g. just a company name had been entered into Antiquity) , no name was shown in the list of recipients (far left of mail merge screen). For such people, the company name is now show.

<b>HTML stock email</b>				
Before producing an HTML stock email, the website must be fully updated, i.e. you must have performed both the FTP Update (images) and the Stock Book Update (text) in the reports section. Previously only the Stock Book Update (text) was required, but this meant you might have not uploaded new images and the emails could go out without some images, which looked unprofessional to the recipient.

<b>PDF stock email</b>				
When producing a PDF stock email, Antiquity previously allowed you to select in-stock items that had no images. Now you can only select in-stock records with an image. This is because the PDF documents look silly without any images!

<b>Download problem</b>				
'User' level staff previously got an error message when trying to check if there were any new emails. This may have happened when on either the Reminders page (when checking for emails) or when actually trying to download them.

<b>Emails with a blank subject</b>				
Fixed a bug whereby if you selected to not store an email in the correspondence log, then the email that was sent did not have a subject.

If you'd started a find and then clicked the button to toggle between list view and detail view, you were still stuck in find mode, which could be confusing. Now if you change the view, the find is cancelled.

<b>Export facility</b>				
Made some improvements and fixed some bugs in the Export Data facility. It's not quite completed yet, but almost there.

<b>VAT status correction</b>				
The calculation that determined the VAT status of an invoice did not correctly resolve if no address or an invalid address had been entered. This was only a problem for data imported from other systems.

<b>Bug in shipping price</b>				
Fixed a bug in the shipping price which did not correctly calculate where the quantity of the item sold was more than 1.

Improved error checking for silly errors made when entering the retail price or trade price for a stock item.

<b>Stock book update to website</b>				
<p>There was a rare occasion where you might have selected Reports &gt; Stock Book Update (to bulk update stock changes to the website) and then at the end of the upload, seen a message saying that 'Another user may have changed stock entries while the upload was taking place. Please perform the upload again.' Even if you performed the action again, the message kept reappearing. This was due to a problem on records where you had not entered a retail price or possibly entered a price of 0 by mistake and checked the option to show the price on the website and / or make it available to buy online. If the price is not valid, the two checkboxes will now be automatically unchecked. The error message has also been modified.</p>

<b>Purchase price</b>				
<p>We removed the 'Buyers Premium' from the list of options when entering the cost price of a stock item. This is because the buyers premium (and VAT on it) can be deducted as costs as part of the Margin Scheme calculations. Also corrected the misleading help text (when user clicks the ? button next to the purchase costs fields)</p>				
<b>Minor bug fix</b>	<b>Stock</b>	115	18/06/2009	2.3
<b>Preview when creating stock PDF</b>				
<p>In most parts of Antiquity when you go to print a document or create a PDF, holding down the SHIFT key will show you a preview. In the stock module, if you clicked the Make PDF button, the main image did not show in the preview window. This has been fixed.</p>

<b>Website credit card fix</b>				
<p>If the user goes to pay with a credit card which is refused, the start dates for the card were incorrectly reset when he was returned to the card details page.</p>

<b>Website shipping address display</b>				
<p>The shipping address was not displayed consistently throughout the order process and afterwards, when viewing the My Orders page. Not all lines of the address showed on all screens.</p>

<b>My Orders - calculation error</b>
