<b>Print contact information page</b>				
In the Contacts module, you can now print an A4 page that summarises the contacts main details - useful if you're going to visit someone and want to take their details with you. The page includes main contact name, company name, main address, telephone numbers for the main contact, (up to 3) other people, (up to 5) other addresses, sales history, source of enquiry, marketing categories and mailing lists.

<b>Credit notes functionality completed</b>				
You can now create credit notes for customers. Only items previously sold to a customer (stock or non-stock) can be credited to them.

<b>Show on web only categories with stock in them</b>				
You can now choose to only show on the web stock categories that have stock items in them. This ensures customers won't ever see the 'No items in this category' message. Whenever you update the website, Antiquity will now update the category list to ensure only categories with stock are displayed. Only categories that are marked as 'On' in the Admin screen will be displayed; categories marked as 'Off' will never be shown on the website even if there is stock in them - thus giving you complete control.

<b>Added highlight to identify current module more easily</b>				
Added a highlight behind the top level button to make it clearer which module is currently in use, e.g. Contacts, Stock, Invoices etc.

<b>Find information</b>				
Imagine that you're in the Contacts module of Antiquity and you now want to go and find a specific stock record... Previously, if you wanted to find something, you first clicked the top level navigation button to go to the correct module of Antiquity (e.g. the Stock module) and then had to click the Find button in that module. However you often go into a module wanting to find something... Now if you press the SHIFT key when clicking the module button for Contacts, Stock, Invoices or Purchases, it goes to that module and automatically goes into Find mode ready for you to enter your search criteria.

<b>Printing - CTRL P</b>				
When pressing CTRL+P (Win) or ⌘+P (Mac) in the Contacts, Stock, Invoices, Purchases or email modules, the appropriate page will now be printed, rather than just a screen-shot (as previously).

<b>Shipping insurance</b>				
You can now manually edit / override the shipping insurance amount on individual items on an invoice, where required.

<b>Address verification in Invoices</b>				
Improved the address verification in invoices, to ensure the address has been correctly entered. A highlighted message now appears over the address if it is not valid.

<b>Changes to "Write Off"</b>				
In line with the change in item 197, we have also removed the write off value fields which previously were displayed in the details tab of the invoice screen. A few changes have also been made to the calculations which accounted for write off in the share partners tab as well. Write off is currently for record keeping and informative purposes only.

<b>New features when setting up stock categories</b>				
In the Admin screen for setting up stock categories, you could previously click a 'View Stock' button to show a list of respective stock items. This button showed a list of all stock items in the selected category. Also previously it displayed the number of items in the category and the number of items 'in stock' for the category. We have now added a column showing the number of items marked as 'Show on Web' for each category. The "View Stock" button has been removed and you can now click instead on any of the three numbers being displayed ('show pieces', 'in stock' and 'on web') to display the respective stock items in a list.

<b>Include Circa Year on website</b>				
Added an option to include the 'Circa (Year)' entered in the stock screen to the website detail page. If the option is selected in Admin, then the Circa (Year) - where entered - will be added to the description on the website. Using this option means that you will not have to type the year in the description as well.

Added a field to enter the date of a restorer's invoice in the Shares and Restoration tab of the stock screen.

<b>Changes to "Write Off" usage &amp; Margin Scheme VAT</b>				
<p>A VAT expert has clarified a loop hole regarding calculating Margin Scheme VAT where part or all of the value of the value of the stock item had been written off. Previously, when an item was sold that had been partially or fully wirtte off in the stock module, Antiquity reduced the equivalent purchase cost by the write off percentage which resulted in a larger M/S VAT liability when the item was eventually sold. The HMRC documentation states, "The purchase price you enter in your stock book must be the price on the invoice agreed between you and the seller. You must not alter the purchase price ...". The expert has clarified that the process previously used by Antiquity did make sense because it avoids double-accounting for the loss - so plays on the safe side of the loop hole; however, the HMRC documentation is clear. This loophole allows an antique dealer to benefit from the write off from a tax perspective whilst still calculating the M/S VAT using the original purchase price. It is a double-accounting of sorts. Nevertheless, we have now changed Antiquity so that the write off value is no longer considered when calculating M/S VAT. Please note that no changes have been made to invoices created in older versions of Antiquity.</p>

<b>Delivery note</b>				
<p>Previously, if no delivery address had been selected when you clicked the button to print a delivery note, Antiquity asked you to select a delivery address. Now, when clicking the button, if no delivery address has been selected, Antiquity assumes the invoice address will be used.</p>

<b>Adjusted tab order on reports screen</b>				
<p>When you go into the reports screen, the 'Website &amp; Image Updates' tab is now the first tab. This makes sense as it is the most commonly used tab for updating stock on the website.</p>

<b>Show on Web options</b>				
<p>Made some changes to items required in order to show an item on the website. Antiquity now takes into account whether or not you have the shopping cart turned on or off. The 'Web Error' red checkbox (at the top of the Stock Status area) now also takes into account whether or not you have the shopping cart turned on or off.</p>

<b>Address bug in Invoices</b>				
<p>Fixed a bug which meant that if an address was used for an invoice and that address record was later deleted from the contacts screen, the invoice may have lost its VAT / export calculations.</p>

<b>Fixed some problems uploading images by FTP</b>				
Some users (Windows only, Mac's had no problems) experienced problems uploading images using the automated FTP procedure (button in the Reports screen). We've made some improvements to dramatically reduce the problem, but some errors may still be reported. We're working with the FTP plug-in manufacturer to resolve the remaining issues.

<b>Find invoice by stock number</b>				
On invoices, you can now click in the stock number field when in find mode, enabling you to find an invoice by stock number. (Note: The functionality in Browse mode has not changed, i.e. clicking on the stock number will take you to the respective stock record.)

<b>Fixed problem with non-stock only invoice</b>				
When creating an invoice for non-stock items only (other products & services), there was a rare problem that when you clicked the Continue button, none of the items were transferred to the invoice. The solution was to add a stock item, then once transferred, remove the stock item from the invoice. This has been fixed.

<b>Fixed rounding error on other services items</b>				
There was a minor rounding error that occurred in rare cases when adding an 'other services' item to an invoice and using the 'Include VAT' option. For example, if you entered an item at £125 including VAT, when transferred to the invoice it would have shown £125.01.

<b>Fixed cost price error on other services items</b>				
There was a rare problem with 'other services' items that were added to an invoice where the user changed the 'cost price' from the default cost price for that product to zero. This error would have resulted in the original cost price being used on the invoice, resulting in an incorrect gross profit calculation.

<b>Stock categories - copy URL link button</b>				
In Preferences > Stock Categories, when using the Copy URL link button, you were unable to copy/paste the URL displayed in the dialog box. We have changed the way this works, so now it just copies the URL link directly to the clipboard, ready for you to paste into your email template or other program, as appropriate.
